RE: Nonrenewal of Insurance Producer License

Dear Mr. Redmond,

This letter is to notify you the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") is not renewing your nonresident insurance producer application. The reason for the nonrenewal is as follows:

You submitted a renewal application for an individual nonresident insurance producer license to the South Dakota Division of Insurance ("Division") on October 2, 2017. You answered "no" to all of the application questions, specifically, the question regarding whether you had been named in an administrative action that had not been previously reported to the Division. However, our investigation showed that you were subject to administrative actions in the state of Nebraska and the state of Oregon in 2017, which were not reported to the Division. The Division attempted to contact you on October 6, 2017 via email and letter requesting an explanation as to why you provided incorrect information in the application and a copy of the administrative action. The Division never received a response. You also failed to respond to Division inquiries dated October 24, 2017 and November 28, 2017.

Due to the above, your license application is denied pursuant to SDCL §§ 58-30-167(1) for providing incorrect information in an application, 58-30-167(2) and (9) for violating any insurance laws or rules and having your license revoked in another state, and 58-33-66(1) for failing to respond to the Division.

Please note this denial is considered an administrative action which will be reported to the database maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. If an administrative action occurs, an insurance producer may be required to report the action to any and all states in which an insurance license is held and in accordance with the timeframes and requirements of each state.

Pursuant to SDCL § 58-30-168, you may make a written request to the Division of Insurance within thirty (30) days of the date of this denial for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this decision to deny your license.
