**ORDER REVOKING
CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY**

IMPERIAL CASUALTY AND INDEMNITY COMPANY (hereinafter "the Company"), whose mailing address of record is 300 West Osborn Rd., #500, Phoenix, AZ 85013-3926 is an insurance company holding a certificate of authority to transact business in the State of South Dakota;

The South Dakota Division of Insurance has received information that the Company's Certificate of Authority has been suspended and terminated in its state of domicile.

Pursuant to SDCL §§ 58-6-44 & 58-6-45, a hearing for the revocation of an insurer's certificate of authority is not required when a company's certificate of authority has been suspended or revoked by its state of domicile.


Therefore, pursuant to SDCL §§ 58-6-44 and 58-6-49, it is hereby ORDERED that the Company's Certificate of Authority to transact business in the State of South Dakota is hereby revoked; and it is further

ORDERED that, pursuant to SDCL § 58-6-61, this Order automatically suspends authority of any insurance producers to act as insurance producers of the Company in this state; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order may not be used by any person for any competitive purpose or used in a manner that would violate SDCL Chapter 58-33.

This Order may be appealed to the Circuit Court and South Dakota Supreme Court pursuant to SDCL Chapter 1-26.


